SEEKING INFORMATION


On Wednesday August 20, 2008 at approximately 4:48PM, the Winthrop Police Department responded to the area of Herman Street in Winthrop on the report of a child being enticed to enter a stranger's motor vehicle. Responding Officers interviewed an eight year old juvenile male who stated that a white male in a silver colored four door motor vehicle stopped next to him and stated, "Can you help me find my dog?" The child, who was riding his bicycle at the time, immediately rode away and notified his parents.

The white male operating the motor vehicle was described as wearing a tan colored cowboy type hat that was pulled down low over his eyes. His shirt was described as a dress shirt, light in color, with short sleeves and multi-colored horizontal stripes. He was believed to be wearing light colored full length pants.

No additional information was provided in regards to the motor vehicle other than that there may have been a purple colored plant located in the back seat of the vehicle.

A Police Sketch Artist from the University of Massachusetts Police Department is interviewing the victim and a composite sketch will be made available when completed.

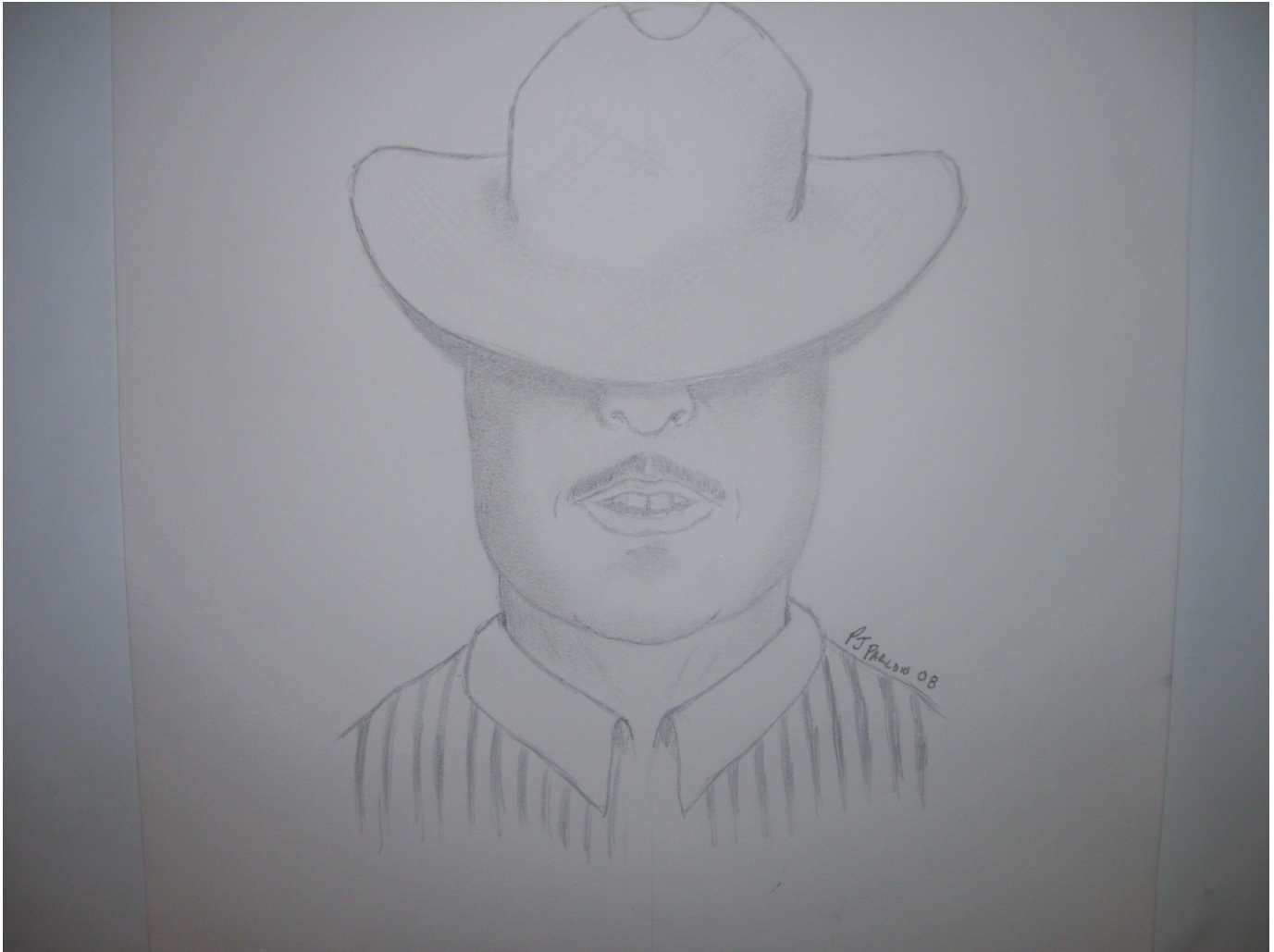
