3) TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By signing this quotation, the bidder acknowledges and agrees to the following terms and conditions:

- 1) This Request for Price Quotation is governed by the provisions of M.G.L. c. 30B, and/or c.149.
- 2) Unless otherwise stated, the quantities set forth are **ESTIMATES ONLY**. The Town reserves the right to purchase the items specified in any amount less than the estimated amount.
- 3) The Town is exempt from the following taxes: sales, excise and Federal transportation.
- 4) Applicable Permits must be obtained, however, the Town will waive all Permit Fees.
- 5) The Town reserves the right to reject any or all bids when the Town determines that it is in the best interest of the Town to do so.
- 6) The Town will award the contract to the responsible bidder offering the needed quality of supply or service at the lowest quotation.
- 7) Quotes may not be withdrawn for a period of 90 days from the date next to the signature of the bidder.
- 8) All supplies must be property packaged; damaged supplies will not be accepted.
- 9) Rejected supplies will be returned to the vendor at the vendor's sole risk and expense.
- 10) The vendor shall comply with all applicable Federal, State, and Local laws.
- 11) Where the unit price and the total price are at variance, the unit price will prevail.
- 12) The vendor shall defend at its sole cost and expense, including attorney's fees, actions or claims brought against the Town of Winthrop and save the Town from loss, cost, judgment, expense or damage by reason of actual or alleged infringement of patent, royalties, or damages arising from the transaction.
- 13) **MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEETS:** Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 111 F, §§8, 9, 10, the vendor agrees to submit a Material Safety Data Sheet for each toxic or hazardous substance or mixture containing such substance when deliveries are made. The vendor agrees to comply with all requirements set forth in the pertinent laws set forth above.
- 14) In performance of this contract, the vendor shall not discriminate on the grounds of race, color, religion, national origin, age or sex in employment practices or in the selection or retention of subcontractors, and in the procurement of material or rental of equipment. The Town may cancel, terminate, or suspend the contract in whole or in part for any violation of this paragraph.
- 15) The vendor shall not assign, sell, subcontract or otherwise transfer any interest in this contract without the prior written consent of the Town.
