



Impact of the Failed Proposition 2 ½ Override

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two vacant Firefighter positions will not be filled • One Fire Engine will be taken out of service approximately 30% of the year • Response times will be delayed • Overlapping calls, motor vehicle accidents, and responses to Deer Island will consume all of the department's available resources • The department's ability to respond to out of town emergencies will be affected • Calls for emergency service may be delayed until Boston or Revere Fire Companies can respond 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shift levels will be maintained as a result of a additional funding secured through a state grant • The School Resource Officer will be forced to split their time between the High and Middle Schools 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Three Public Works positions will not be filled • The Catch Basin program has been scaled back from three days to two • The street sweeping program has been suspended until September • Care for graveside plantings and shrubs will be reduced • Specialty maintenance of individual grave sites will be reduced • Reductions in clerical staff will delay calls for assistance and information, especially during emergencies
