SCHEDULE A
(Fine - \$75.00 each)

VIOLATION CODE:

- 06. **Driveway:** Upon, in front of (block), or impede in anyway any driveway.
- 07. **Crosswalk:** Upon any crosswalk.
 - A. **Sidewalk:** Upon any sidewalk.
- 16. **Fire Hydrant:** Upon any street or highway within 10 feet of a fire hydrant.
- 17. **Fire Station Exit or Entrance:** The space in front of or within 30 feet of either wall of a fire station on both sides of the street.
- 18. **Within Intersection.**
- 19. **Obstruction of Traffic:** Upon any roadway where the parking of a vehicle will not leave a clear and unobstructed lane at least 10 feet wide for passing traffic.
- 21. **Restricted Area: Fire Lane:** No stopping, fire lane.
- 24. **Municipal Lots:** (Over posted limit.)
 - a. Two-hour limit in all municipal lots, except Town Hall municipal lot, from 7:00am to 5:00pm; reserved areas by permit only. Subject to tow and fine.
 - b. One-hour limit in the Town Hall municipal lot, from 7:00am to 5:00pm; reserved areas by permit only. Subject to tow and fine.
- 25. **Private Road:** Upon, in front of (block), or impede in anyway any private road.
- 26. **Double Parked.**
- 27. **72-Hour:** Upon any way for a continuous period of seventy-two (72) hours or more.
- 29. **Emergency Vehicle Zone:** In or upon any emergency ambulance vehicle zone.
- 35. **OTHER:** _____.

(Fine - \$40.00 each)

13. **Commercial Vehicle:**
 - A. **One-hour limit as detailed under Town of Winthrop Bylaw 275-33(A).**
 - B. **One-hour limit in municipal lots as detailed under Town of Winthrop Bylaw 275-33(B).**
 - C. **No overnight parking at Town Landing as defined under Town of Winthrop Bylaw 118-1(D).**
22. **Obstruction of Snow Plowing or Snow Removal: Upon any way so as to impede the removal of plowing of snow and ice, except vehicles parked in accordance with regulations for all-night parking.**
23. **Snow Warning/Parking Ban: Effective each year from December 15 to April 1, as detailed under Town of Winthrop Bylaw, Section.282-2. Removal of vehicles from streets; excepted streets.**
34. **Street Sweeping: Impeding of street sweeping, cleaning of streets.**

01. **Restricted Area:**
 - A. **Loading Zone.**
 - B. Deleted from Code 01
 - C. **No Parking - Anytime.**
 - D. **No Parking – This side.**

 - F. **Travel Lane.**
 - G. **Island or Center Strip.**
 - H. **Tow Zone.**
02. **Over 12 inches from Curb.**
03. **Wrong Direction.**
04. **Bus Stop: Parking or stopping in a bus stop.**
05. **Taxi Cab Stand: In a taxicab stand.**
09. **Within 20 feet of an Intersecting Way: Upon any street or highway within 20 feet of an intersection way, except alleys.**
10. **Angle – Parallel Parking Zone.**
11. **Angle Parking Only.**
12. **Designated Area: Not parked within a designated area; within the allocated lines defined on the street or parking lot.**
14. **Parking Overtime:**
 - a. **Posted 15 Minutes: Over posted limit.**
 - b. **Posted 30 Minutes: Over posted limit.**
 - c. **Posted 1 Hour: Over posted limit.**
15. **Left wheels to curb.**
28. **Public Assemblage: No driver shall park any vehicle in front of the entrance to any school, church, theater, hotel, hospital, public building or any place of public assemblage in the town.**
30. **Resident Permit:**
 - a. Failure to display valid residential parking permit from 1:00am to 5:00am.
 - b. Failure to display valid visitor pass.
 - c. Expired, mis-use or beyond allocated time of visitor Pass allowed under parking program.
 - d. Expired residential parking permit.
31. **OTHER: _____.**
(Defined by officer).
32. **Expired Registration Sticker: No valid or expired registration plate or registration sticker.**

(Fine - \$25.00 each)

33. **Expired Inspection Sticker:** No valid or expired certificate of inspection sticker.
37. **Display for Sale:** No person shall park upon a street or highway in the town any vehicle displayed for sale.

SCHEDULE D
(Fine - \$250.00)

22. **Handicapped:**
- a. To occupy or obstruct any parking space reserved for handicapped or disabled vehicle.
 - b. To obstruct in any manner any curb ramp designated for the use by handicapped persons or wheelchair as means of egress to a street or public way.
