



Winthrop Police Bulletin

Chapter 26, CURFEW

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Annual Town Meeting of the Town of Winthrop 3-24-1969 by Art. 31 as Ch. 9, Secs. 9-4, 9-5 and 9-6 of the 1969 Code. Amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 26-1. Time restrictions; exceptions.

No child under the age of sixteen years shall be, loiter or remain in or upon any street, way, highway, park or other public place in this town between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. unless such child is accompanied by or under the control of a parent, guardian or other person having the legal custody or care of such child or unless in the performance or returning from the performance of an errand or duty directed by such parent, guardian or other person having the legal custody or care of such child or unless in the performance of or going to or returning from some lawful employment or duty; and no such child while performing such errand, duty or employment, or while going to or returning from the performance thereof, shall loiter or remain upon any such street, way, highway, park or other public place within such period of time.

§ 26-2. Notification upon violation.

The Chief of Police shall keep a record of all violations of § 26-1 and shall cause to be notified thereof one of the parents, the guardian or other person having the legal custody or care of such child.
