To qualify for a resident parking permit, applicant must be a resident of Winthrop. All payments, fees, fines, parking tickets, and taxes including excise tax owed to the Town **MUST** be paid in full before receiving a permit. You are prohibited by ordinance from being issued any residential parking permit if the debt is not paid in full. Vehicles bearing commercial, repair, dealer, livery, or taxi plates do not qualify for issuance or use of a resident permit or placard. Copies of **TWO** of the residency documents listed on the back of this application must be submitted along with this application.

Only one sticker can be issued to a registration per year without proof that the previous sticker is not still on the car bearing that registration number.

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Vehicles bearing Commercial, Livery, Taxi, dealer, or Repair plates are NOT eligible for a permit. Trailers and any bus or camper that exceeds 25 feet in length are also ineligible for a permit.

Misrepresentation of eligibility will result in application denial, permit revocation, and/or fines as defined by ordinance in addition to loss of application fee.

Instructions:

1. Submit this completed application, proof of current motor vehicle registration, and proof of residency. If you are submitting your application in-person prior to December 1, 2019 or by mail at any time, you **MUST** provide a self-addressed, stamped envelope. Applications may be submitted to the following location along with all required supporting documentation and the appropriate fee (see below):

2. Permits **MUST** be affixed to the interior of the vehicle's windshield on the lower, driver's side corner. On motorcycles without windshields, the permit must be affixed to the left, front fork. Permits from previous years must be removed prior to affixing the new permit. Temporary and Visitor's placards must be displayed on the vehicle's dashboard on the driver's side, and all printed information must be visible. Failure to display the permit or placard in the correct place may result in a ticket being issued as if the vehicle was not displaying a permit. Vehicles parked on all town streets and municipal lots between 1:00 AM and 5:00 AM must display a valid permit or placard. Vehicles parked in violation of the ordinance are subject to receiving a parking ticket in the amount of \$25.00.
3. Temporary Placards may only be issued under the following circumstances:
 1. A new resident who moved to Winthrop within 30 days of the application date;
 2. A resident who is eligible for a permit, chooses not to have one on their vehicle, and needs to park on the street due to construction that makes their driveway inaccessible;
 3. A resident who has a valid permit on their vehicle, but the vehicle displaying the permit is under repair;
 4. A resident under the Tax Collector's list of exceptions.
4. Residents may apply for a visitor placard. Visitor placards are no longer automatically issued and are available only by request for an additional fee. Only one visitor placard may be issued per household. Visitor placards may not be used on a vehicle owned or operated by a Winthrop resident.

Any TWO of the following may be submitted as Proof of Residency:

- A valid driver's license with correct address
- A valid MA motor vehicle registration with correct address
- A real estate tax bill, municipal water bill, or utility bill with the applicant's name
- A rental or lease agreement for rental where the applicant resides
- Such other proof acceptable to the revenue collections department

Resident Permit Fees as of March 3, 2015:

Resident Parking Sticker: (per vehicle)	\$5.00
Visitor Placard: (limit one per household)	\$10.00
Temporary Placard:	\$5.00
Fees will be waived for residents with valid DV or HP placards or plates and all residents age 65 or older.	
The fee for a 2020 resident permit between Oct.1 and Dec. 1 will be half of the fee listed. Applicants will need to reapply for a 2021 permit.	
There will be no charge for a resident parking sticker if the applicant received a temporary placard as a new resident and the placard is returned prior to the expiration date with the permit application.
